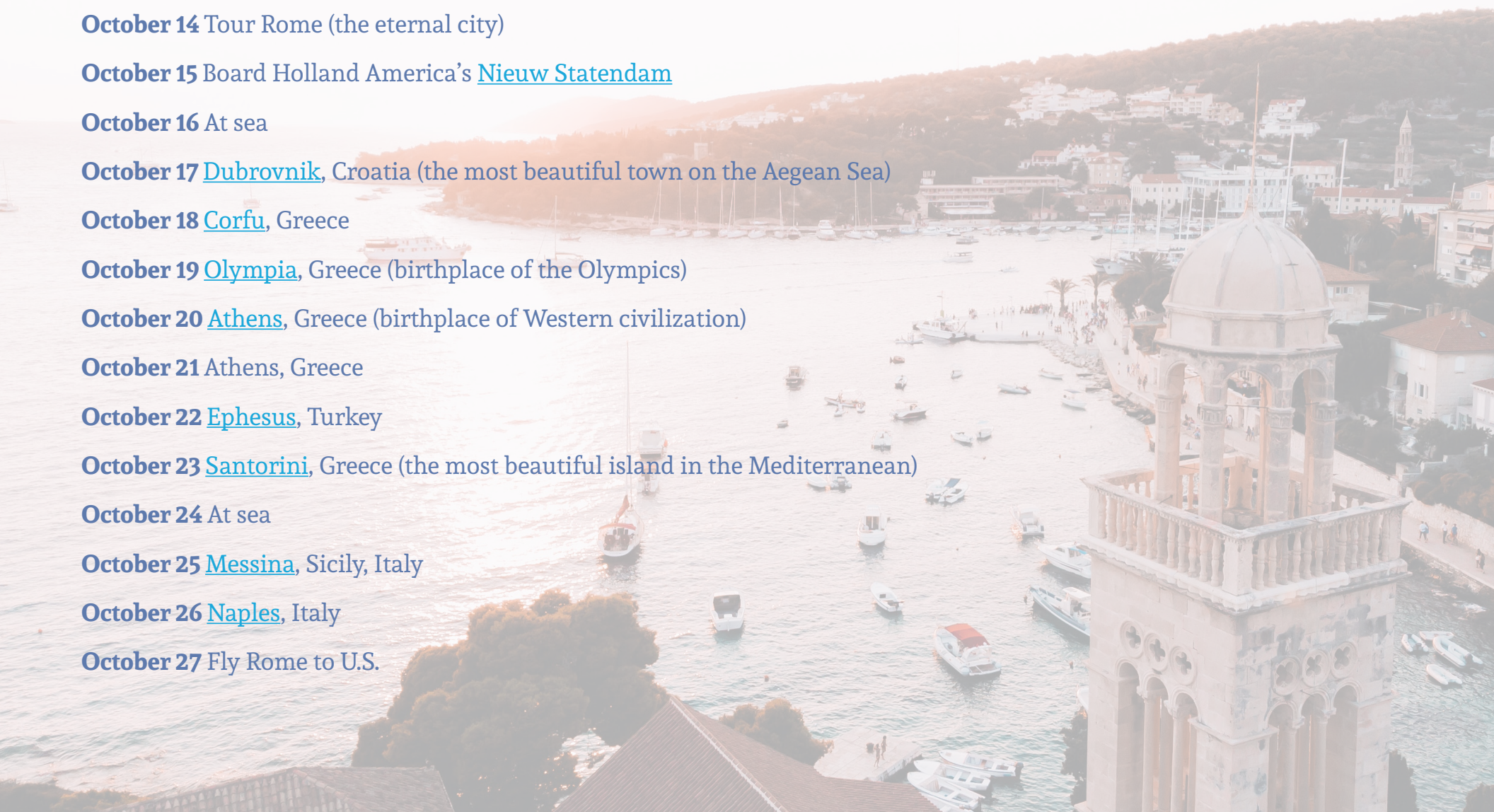

COST & DETAILS

Trip Cost

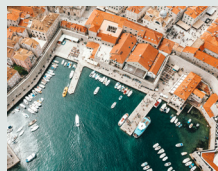
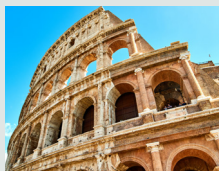
\$5,950 per person, double occupancy

Includes:

- Roundtrip airfare from DFW (if you provide your own airfare, subtract \$1,200 from the price listed above)
- Hotel (monastery) in Rome
- Twelve-day cruise in a balcony room including taxes and fees
- Private coach and tour guides in Rome, Dubrovnik, Corfu, Olympia, Athens (two days), Ephesus, Santorini, Messina
- Lunches in Athens
- Entry fee to major sights
- Transportation to and from airports, cities, and ship

Does Not Include:

- Lunches and one dinner in Rome and lunch on most shore excursions
- Shore excursion in Naples; you can book this through Holland America
- Gratuities on the ship
- Trip insurance. You may consider two types of insurance:
 - Cruise insurance - \$250 for balcony. This only covers the cost of the cruise, if cancelled due to certain reasons (medical, etc.).
 - Trip insurance - Numerous companies offer trip insurance to cover cancelled trips, medical emergencies, and other issues. If you think an insurance policy would be beneficial, pursue this on your own. Options include Generali Global Assistance (generalitravelinsurance.com), Travel Guard (travelguard.com), and Travelex (travelex.com). Some policies may also cover the cost of the cruise.



Payment Schedule/Cancellations/Refunds

- Deposit - \$900 per person (\$500 is nonrefundable). The trip is limited to the first 40 people who make a deposit.
- 1st payment of \$1,600 due February 1, 2020 (\$500 of this payment is nonrefundable for a total of \$1,000 nonrefundable.)
- 2nd payment of \$1,000 due May 1, 2020 (\$800 of this payment is nonrefundable for a total of \$1,800 nonrefundable.)
- Final payment due July 1, 2020.
