


Image Above: The Library of Celsus in ancient Ephesus, constructed in the 2nd century CE










# 15-DAY TRIP ITINERARY



## COST & DETAILS

Trip Cost: \$6,800 per person, double occupancy

#### Includes:

- Roundtrip airfare from DFW (If you provide your own airfare, subtract \$1,300 from the price listed above.)
- Two nights in Santa Brigida Monastery in Rome
- Eleven-night cruise
  - Unobstructed balcony cabin, prepaid gratuities, unlimited wi-fi, classic drink package that includes wine and special drinks, taxes and fees included
- · Private coach and tour guides in Rome, Messina, Istanbul, Athens, and Ephesus
- Entry fee to major sights
- · Transportation to and from airports, cities, and ship

#### Does Not Include:

- · One dinner in Rome and lunches on most shore excursions.
- · Shore excursion in Naples; you can book this through Celebrity
- Extra charges on the ship
- Trip insurance. If you think an insurance policy would be beneficial, pursue this on your own. Consider two types of insurance:
  - · Cruise insurance \$280 for balcony. This only covers the cost of the cruise.
  - Trip insurance Numerous companies offer trip insurance to cover cancelled trips, medical emergencies, and other issues. These policies would cover your entire trip (airfare and cruise). Options include Generali Global Assistance (generalitravelinsurance.com), Travel Guard (travelguard.com), and Travelex (travelex.com).











Note: Cruise lines will not confirm the price of a cruise until a deposit is made and names given. This price (\$6,800) includes a promotion Celebrity is running until the end of February. Then, they will have another promotion which may not be as good as the one they currently offer so the price of the trip may go up slightly. As the ship continues to fill, the price will increase. (Many cruises are sailing at only 70-80% capacity so ships will likely fill up faster.)

Note for single travelers: Ideally, you can find a friend who will be your roommate, or, on most of my trips I've been able to find a roommate for single travelers. But if not, you'll need to pay a single supplement for the cruise part of the trip.

## COST & DETAILS (CONTINUED)

#### **Covid Protocol**

In December 2021, my family and I traveled on the Queen Mary 2 from London to NYC. We felt safe and protected from Covid. In April 2022 we are sailing from Florida to Europe. So we are not hesitant to travel and think that the protocols adopted by the cruise industry are good and adequate. I think by fall 2022 Covid will be even less of a threat.

Currently, all cruise lines and most countries require passengers to be vaccinated and many require the booster.

If Celebrity cancels a trip due to Covid your money will be refunded or you may opt for 125% future cruise credit (FCC). Currently, airlines are quite liberal about allowing ticked passengers to cancel airfare and get credit for future flights. But, both of these policies (cruise and airfare) may change.

Covid policies change regularly. Hopefully, by October restrictions will have been eased.











## Payment Schedule/Cancellations/Refunds

- Deposit \$600 per person (nonrefundable). The trip is limited to the first 40 people who make a deposit.
- First payment of \$1,600 due March 1, 2022 (\$400 of this payment is nonrefundable for a total of \$1,000 nonrefundable.)
- Second payment of \$2,600 due May 1, 2022 (\$800 of this payment is nonrefundable for a total of \$1,800 nonrefundable.)
- Final payment of \$2,000 due June 15, 2022
