

THREE DAYS IN AMSTERDAM

Amsterdam, capital city of the Netherlands and one of the great cities of Europe, is known for its artistic heritage, elaborate canal system, and narrow houses with gabled facades—legacies of the city's 17th-century Golden Age. Its Museum District houses three world-class museums: the Van Gogh Museum, the Rijksmuseum which showcases the Dutch masters including works by Rembrandt and Vermeer, and modern art at the Stedelijk Museum.

It's called "Venice of the North" because 60 miles of canals wind through the old city (Venice, in comparison, has 38 miles of canals). It is the bicycle capital of the world (there are more bicycles than residents). We'll also visit the Dutch countryside to see windmills, cheese farms, and a clog factory.

COST & DETAILS

TRIP COST: \$6,850 PER PERSON, DOUBLE OCCUPANCY

Includes

- Roundtrip airfare from DFW (If you provide your own airfare, subtract \$1,200 from the price listed above.)
- Two nights at the 4-star <u>Park Plaza Victoria</u> hotel in Amsterdam
- Twelve-night cruise in a balcony cabin (taxes and fees included)
- Private coach and tour guides in Amsterdam, Berlin, Gdansk, Visby, Tallinn, Stockholm, and Copenhagen
- Entry fee to major sights
- All gratuities for local tour guides and bus drivers
- · Transportation to and from airports, cities, and ship

Note: During Covid, to entice travelers to sail on their ships, cruise companies offered a free package that included gratuities, beverage package, and wi-fi. Near the end of Covid, the cruise lines began charging \$600 for the three perks. Now that travel is in great demand, ships are charging \$1,000+ per person for the package and both guests in the cabin must pay for the perks (\$2,000 per cabin). I've done the math and it's just no longer financially beneficial to pay for the perks, so I'm not offering that as an option. If you want the +3 package, contact me and I'll add that to your cost. I have negotiated a \$600 per cabin onboard credit, which will help offset the three expenses.

Note for single travelers: Ideally, you can find a friend who will be your roommate, or, on most of my trips I've been able to find a roommate for single travelers. But if not, you'll need to pay a single supplement of \$2,800.

Does Not Include

- One dinner in Amsterdam and lunches on most shore excursions
- · Gratuities and personal charges on the ship
- Trip insurance. Numerous companies offer trip insurance which cover cancelled trips, medical emergencies, and other issues. Options include <u>Generali Global Assistance</u> (generalitravelinsurance.com), <u>Travel Guard</u> (travelguard.com), and <u>Travelex</u> (travelex.com). If you think an insurance policy would be beneficial, pursue this on your own.

Note: The cost of the trip stated in this brochure is good until May 1, 2024. After that, the price may go up if cruise and airfare fares change.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE/CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

- Deposit \$600 per person (nonrefundable). The trip is limited to the first 50 people who make a deposit and submit a trip registration form.
- First payment of \$1,700 due January 15, 2024 (\$1,000 of this payment is nonrefundable for a total of \$1,600 nonrefundable.)
- Second payment of \$2,650 due March 15, 2024 (\$1,000 of this payment is nonrefundable for a total of \$2,600 nonrefundable.)
- Final payment of \$1,900 due May 1, 2024 (on this date, the entire cost of the trip is nonrefundable)
